



HOME – ACADEMY AGREEMENT

This agreement between Home and the Academy reflects our values and ethos, enabling us to create a climate in which all students can succeed in their learning. By working in partnership, Home and the Academy can encourage students to become independent learners and prepare them to become responsible citizens as they move into higher education or into the world of work.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Academy

To create a positive Climate for Learning, the Academy will:

- Provide learning opportunities to meet the needs of individual students.
- Encourage and reward success for all students.
- Promote the values of Care, Consideration, Co-operation and Respect for all.
- Provide good communication between Home and the Academy, including the provision of Progress Review days and Subject Evenings.
- Encourage students to take responsibility for their actions.

To create a positive climate for learning for all, the Academy will not accept:

- Disruption to learning.
- The use of mobile phones/personal electronic devices during the course of the Academy day.
- Foul and abusive language or language that is derogatory to any part of our Academy community.
- Bullying.
- Behaviour that places the health and safety of any individual or groups of individuals at risk, including fighting
- Smoking.
- Continued failure to adhere to the Academy Uniform Dress Code.

Parents

To support the learning of their children, Parents will:

- Ensure the good attendance and punctuality of your child.
- Arrange family holidays during school holidays to minimise disruption to learning for your child, unless exceptional circumstances warrant a need for them to be taken during term time (e.g. Military personnel).
- Support the Academy in creating a positive Climate for Learning.
- Co-operate with requests from the Academy where there has been a breach of the 'Climate for Learning' policy by supporting the system for consequences
- Inform the Academy of any issues within the community that may have a negative impact on your child's behaviour or safety during the school day.
- Support the Academy's code of dress by ensuring that correct uniform is worn daily and that PE kit is brought when necessary.
- Regularly scrutinise your child's work and Planner.
- Monitor the completion of home learning.
- Attend Progress Review days and Subject Evenings to enable you to monitor the progress of your child and support their learning.

Students

To help me make the most of my learning opportunities, I will:

- Work to the best of my ability at all times.
- Take responsibility for completing and evaluating all my work including home learning.
- Take responsibility for being equipped for all lessons with my books, writing equipment and PE kit when needed.
- Take responsibility for arriving at the Academy on time and wearing the correct uniform.
- Use my Student Planner to help my personal organisation and learning.
- Show Care, Consideration, Co-operation and Respect for all and take account of other people's feelings.
- Not take part in any activity that may put the safety of an individual or groups of individuals at risk including fighting.

- Take care of and show respect for the Academy environment.
- Aim for 100% attendance.
- Be on time for all lessons.
- Not use my mobile phone or any other personal electronic device during the academy day.
- Endeavour to act as a responsible citizen whilst wearing my Academy uniform (including out of school and in the community).
