**Year 9 Options and Parents' Evening – Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2026 – 4:00pm to 7:00pm**

We are delighted to invite you into the Academy to discuss your child's option choices for next year and to discuss their current achievements.

We will be pairing up our options evening with a parents evening for the core subjects – Maths, English, Science and French.

**Options Evening**

Prior to options evening we are offering students taster sessions of the options subjects. This will run on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2026 during the normal school day. For this your child will be asked to select 4 options they would like to sample; this will be done during one of their lessons this week. Please note that the taster sessions your child chooses will not impact their final options choices, i.e. they are not committing to any subjects at this stage.

On the evening itself there will be two presentations from the Principal and the Vice Principal guiding you through the process to ensure you and your child make the right decisions. We strongly recommend joining us for one of our presentations which will start promptly at **4:10 pm** and **5:30pm**.

You will also have the opportunity to visit the departments within the Porter Building allowing you to:

- Discuss with and observe students taking part in exciting collaborative learning within the different curriculum areas, whilst speaking with curriculum and subject leaders to find out more about each course.
- Meet with experienced Senior Leaders who can provide advice to support your child's choices.
- Meet with our Careers Team to help you and your child to plan and make informed decisions about their futures.

It is our intent to help all students make well judged, informed choices about the optional subjects they choose. To help students with this process, they will receive guidance from subject teachers and senior leaders. There will be an options booklet on our website which will be live on the 10<sup>th</sup> of February 2026 which you will be able to go through them in detail at home. The booklet provides essential information about each of the courses that your child can choose to study at the start of Year 10. There will be an online options form to fill out once your child has made their choices - please do not do this any earlier than the 10<sup>th</sup> of February 2026 as the online form will only become live for this year group on the date given.




Login to the **MCAS Parent Portal**, from the left **Menu** select the **Parents Evening** option. This will open the **Parents Evening** page displaying **Appointments** that can be booked.



### Booking Appointments Manually

The available **Appointments** are displayed in red **Blocks**, click on a **Block** to **Book** your **Appointment**. Then from the listed **Times** click on the word **Book** to the right.

The **Booked Block** will then be removed from the **Appointments** list and displayed below as **Booked**. To remove the **Booking** click on the **X** to the right. The **Appointment** will then display at the top again ready to be **Booked** again.



If the **Time** you wanted has already been **Booked** by yourself or another **Parent**, it will display as **Not Available** and cannot be **Booked**.
